## 2 - Working with LANGUAGE

### **Present Continuous**

We use the Present Continuous to talk about actions happening at the moment. Ex. I am reading a book now.

#### Affirmative

We form the Present Continuous with: subject + to be + verb + ing. To Drink → I am drinking.

### Negative

For the negative we use: subject + to be + not + verb + ing. To play → you are not playing.

### Interrogative

To make questions we use: to be + subject + verb + ing. To Sing → Are you singing?
