□ Starter A-B-C-D-E-F-G-H:

Verb be (present simple), possessive adjectives, definite article, indefinite article, demonstrative pronouns and adjectives, interrogative pronoun (where), prepositions of place.

□ Unit 1:

Verb have got, some-any, interrogative pronoun (when).

Rooms and furniture, personal possessions, dates: months, ordinal numbers, festivals.

□ Unit 2:

Possessive case (& plural nouns), possessive adjectives (plural), adjective order, qualifiers: a bit, (not) very, quite really.

The family, physical description: looks, height, build, hair, eyes.

□ Unit 3:

Present simple like +ing, play, do and go +ing, What? Which? Connectors: and, but, or, object pronouns, so do I, neither do I, oh I do, oh I don't.

Types of music, sports and free-time activities.

□ Unit 4:

Expressions with have (have lunch), the time, both, prepositions of time : at, on, in, adverbs and expressions of frequency.

Daily activities, days of the week, jobs in the house, part-time jobs.

□ Unit 5:

Present continuous, present continuous v present simple, time expressions (at the moment, these days, this week/month/year...)

Everyday activities, personal life, school.

□ Unit 6:

Countable and uncountable nouns, how much? How many? There is, there are, some, any, a few, a little, few, little (too) much, many, a lot of/lots of, not enough.

Food, drink and diet, quantities, cardinal numbers (over 100) and decimals

□ Unit 7:

Would like (to), want (to), would like v like, let's ..., shall we ..., what about / how about +ing, would prefer to, would rather, can: ability. Well, (not) very well.

Meals in Britain, abilities, British/American English.

□ Unit 8:

Verb be: past simple (all forms), past time expressions: (last night,...ago), prepositions of place: at, in. was/were born. Can, could, may: permission and requests

Places, Phrasal verb: turn. Lend v borrow.

□ Unit 9:

Past simple regular and irregular verbs (all forms), interrogative pronoun: how long?

Holiday: accommodation, activities, duration. Means of transport (by train,...). Adjectives of opinion.

□ Unit 10:

Present simple: future (timetables), past simple: regular and irregular verbs (all forms), It takes. Subject/object questions: who? What? Sequences (first, then, next,...) every/some/any/no compounds.

British money, using public transport. Travel phrases. Buildings: shape, material, dimension.

Whose and possessive pronouns.
